Subject 2.Academic Planning of FDP

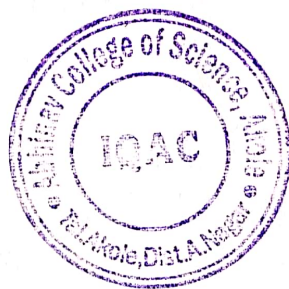

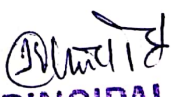
Subject 3.Planning about Implementation Strategies for NEP 2020
